4.1. Description of first aid measures

- First-aid measures after inhalation : Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. In all cases of doubt, or if victim feels unwell seek medical attention.

- Symptoms/injuries after inhalation : Inhalation of dust may cause irritation of the respiratory system.
- Symptoms/injuries after skin contact : May cause sensitisation by skin contact.
- Symptoms/injuries after eye contact : Dusts are mechanical irritants.
